

Appendix 2

Summary of assessing level of suicide risk for adults at risk.

Level of Risk – MILD

Vulnerable adult appearing to suffer mental health difficulties possibly relating to suicidal thoughts but has no plan or intent.

ACTION: Detail on Alert Form, signpost to GP and/ or adult social services.

Level of Risk - MODERATE

Vulnerable adult appearing to suffer mental health difficulties with clear indication of suicidal thoughts but no identified immediate risk or plan to take action.

ACTION: Detail on Alert Form, referral to adult services/ adult mental health care depending on circumstances.

Level of Risk - MODERATE to SEVERE

Vulnerable adult appearing to suffer mental health difficulties relating to suicidal thoughts and has clear indicators like a plan, history of previous attempts or is demonstrating reckless behaviour.

ACTION: Detail on Alert Form, referral to adult services/ adult mental health care depending on circumstances, if necessary, call the Police or Ambulance services.

Level of Risk – SEVERE

Vulnerable adult appearing to suffer mental health difficulties relating to suicidal thoughts and definite immediate risk to life.

ACTION: EMERGENCY PROCEDURES TO ACT IN ORDER TO PRESERVE LIFE AND PROTECT THEM OR OTHERS, REQUEST POLICE SAFE AND WELL CHECK AND, IF NECESSARY CALL AMBULANCE.
